American Red Cross, San Bruno Resource & Recovery Center

- In response to 2011 San Bruno Pipeline Explosion. Expanded mental health services and age appropriate coping strategies for victims still recovering from the trauma.
- Program designed to serve all residents of San Bruno or anyone affected from the explosion.
- District partner since 2011

California Donor Transplant Network for Community Education

- CTDN is an organ procurement organization serving California from Fresno north, Nevada and Arizona.
- Program designed to serve patients in San Mateo County that are waiting for organs. It will also support an outreach education campaign to the Asian Pacific Islander population.

Catholic Charites, Adult Day Health

- Program provides a safe, structured, and stimulating environment that provides therapeutic services for participants who require advanced physical and cognitive treatment. This program will serve approximately 60 frail and chronically ill seniors and 50 of their caregivers.
- 60% of clients are over 85 and 90% have Dementia.

Caminar Medical Clinic

- 40 year community-based support services for individuals with mental health, physical and developmental disabilities.
- Funding will provide support for one part-time Community Support Worker for the Medication Clinic and REACH program. That role is a fundamental part of supporting client stability and independence in the community.
- District partner since 2011

Children's Health Initiative

- Provides healthcare coverage and primary care access for 760 children within District.
- Documented track record of achieving/exceeding goals of outreach and cost effectiveness.
- District partner since 2003

Jewish Family and Children's Services, Seniors at Home

- Goals of the program is to improve health outcomes for at-risk seniors, to prevent re-hospitalization and to prevent unnecessary out-of-home placements, both temporary and permanent.
- Grant will provide "scholarships" for direct home care attendant services for seniors and associate assessment and coordination time by the RN and therapy staff.
- Documented track record of achieving/exceeding goals of outreach and cost effectiveness.

Mid-Peninsula Boys & Girls Club

- Funds will enhance the quality and availability of the Nutritional & Physical Fitness Program for at-risk youth at the San Mateo Clubhouse through one Program Coordinator and one Program Supervisor.
- Program aims to improve the health and physical fitness of youth while offering ways to incorporate health choices into their lives every day.
- Actively collaborates with other community service organizations.
- District partner since 2011

Mills-Peninsula Health Services - Senior Focus

- Funding to support the Alzheimer/Day Care Center and Wise and Well Programs provided by Senior Focus.
- Alzheimer Program is a unique and valued county service serving over 200 residents.

- Wise and Well Programs are located in Senior Centers in San Bruno and San Mateo and provide health screenings, pharmacy "brown bag" clinics, and a wide range of health-related education programs.
- District partner since 1996.

North Peninsula Neighborhood Services

- A San Mateo County Human Services Agency.
- Provides Health Plan enrollment, health and wellness, education, food & shelter, housing, counseling, rental and utility assistance and minor home improvements.

Ombudsman Program of San Mateo County

- Funding for staff and the recruitment and training of volunteers to visit long term and residential facilities to assess care and investigate complaints.
- State funding eliminated in this year's budget.
- Consistently meets/exceeds complaint follow-ups and volunteer recruitment goals.
- District partner since 1997.

Pathway's - Chronic Disease Management

- Program Phase II addressing chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), diabetes, stroke and depression.
- Support of program that coaches patients and families to learn and use self-management tools and techniques so they can maintain their independence and avoid unnecessary re-hospitalizations.

Peninsula Rebuilding Together - "Safe at Home"

- Safe at Home program provides simple home modifications, such as grab bars, ramps, secure railings, etc., in the home setting.
- Rebuilding Together has a 22 year track record of working in the community with seniors. Every applicant is visited personally.

Peninsula Volunteers - Adult Day Health

- Rosener House has provided affordable weekday adult day services for over 30 years. Program allows family members to continue working and maintain their level of living and/or offers respite to those who are serving as caregivers.
- Activities include exercise, creative arts, music, gardening, PT, OT and speech therapy.
- Alzheimer Cafe is a meeting place for education and family support groups.

Samaritan House

- Funding to support operations of the San Mateo Free Clinic that provides primary care and dental services to over 5,000 low income residents of the county.

- Strong history of being a quality service provider, effective fund raiser, and volunteer recruitment and retention.
- District partner since 1998.

San Mateo Medical Association - Hep B Free Program

- The Foundation seeks to eradicate Hepatitis B through a program of community education, outreach, testing and vaccination.
- Program will provide education, outreach, testing and vaccination to residents; and will ensure providers of care to high-risk patients are aware of the threat and take proactive preventative measures.

StarVista - Insights Program & Crisis Center

- **Insights Program for Adolescent substance abuse**
Insights' plan is to treat 200 youths, 65 from the District, who have experienced problematic relationships with mind-altering substances and would do so through a variety of treatment intensities, counseling, and groups.
- **Crisis Intervention and Suicide Prevention Center**
The Crisis Center staff conducts suicide awareness training in high schools, engages in live chat sessions, and handles an average of 13,000 crisis phone calls (27% from District numbers);
- District partner since 1996.

Children's Health Initiative

Community Network for the Underserved - OB Program

- Public/private partnership with county, MPHS, and local private practice physicians.
- Program designed to improve access, provide care within the District for the underserved who live within the District.
- Funds will be used to support the network of participating physicians.
- New partnership since 2009.

Peninsula Jewish Community Center - Get up and Go Program

- The Get Up & Go Program launched in 2007 and provides flexible scheduled transportation for isolated seniors who no longer drive.
- District partner since 2011

San Mateo County - SMART Program

- SMART is the San Mateo County Mental Health Assessment and Referral Team
- The program is operated by AMR (American Medical Response) through a county contract.
- Police use the program daily bringing mental health professionals to individuals needing intervention.
